
Word of Life

Just a bit from Fr. Schmidt

What's in a Name?

By the time you read this, the Diocese of Sioux Falls will likely have three new transitional deacons and three new priests beginning their public ministry this weekend. Please pray that God would guide, bless, and strengthen them in their service of His holy Church. Continue to pray also for many more holy vocations. Three ordained each year is a good number for a diocese our size, but it's still not enough to keep pace with the number of retirements in the near future.

> "O Lord, grant us priests. O Lord, grant us holy priests. O Lord, grant us many holy priests and religious vocations."

In the past few weeks, one important symbol often used in our churches and religious art has come up in conversation quite a few times: **IHS**. You've no doubt seen it before, but we may not be familiar with the whole history and meaning of it. Basically, these three letters are a sort of abbreviation or symbol for the Holy Name of **Jesus**. They are in fact the first three Greek letters of His Name as it appears in the New Testament: IH Σ OY Σ , although the Greek letter sigma (Σ) has been simplified into the more familiar S.

Another variation is JHS, since j's have more recently been introduced into alphabets as the consonant form of the vowel i. J was not a letter of its own in ancient alphabets. Sometimes the three letters are said to be an acronym for the Latin phrase Iesus Hominum Salvator ("Jesus Savior of Men") or another phrase, but these were not likely part of the original intended meaning.

This symbol for the Holy Name (IHS) was used and popularized by the Franciscan St. Bernardino of Siena,

whose feast is on May 20, as he spread devotion to the Holy Name wherever he went. Much like the Jewish reverence for the Name of the God of Israel as He revealed it to Moses on Mt. Sinai (I AM WHO AM or YHWH), Christians have always reverenced the Holy Name of Jesus, the proper Name given to the Incarnate Son of God.

Even naturally, a name serves as a symbol or icon that stands in for the person, gives access and allows us to call upon them. Most especially with a Holy Name of God—who is present everywhere at all times—saying His Name and keeping it always upon our minds and hearts brings us into His presence, or makes us aware of His constant presence, keeping us present to Him even while He is always present to us by His divine nature. "For whoever invokes the Name of the Lord will be saved" (Joel 2:32; Acts 2:21; Rom 10:13).
