### Minor Rogations and the Original Novena

Besides the Major Rogation on April 25—which took the place of an ancient Roman festival with the aim of warding off agricultural disease—the Minor Rogation Days are somewhat newer, observed first in southern France around the year 470 and spreading from there. Today, these are observed in the same way, with processions and prayers, accompanied by personal fasting and penance if possible. The Minor Rogations take place on the Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday before Ascension Thursday. Even in dioceses that transfer the celebration of the Ascension to the following Sunday, it still makes the most sense to keep the Rogations on Monday through Wednesday.

If you'd like to join the **processions** on these days to pray for crops, livestock, and many other needs—again, starting and ending inside the church and processing around the block if weather permits—I'll be having them in **Hoven on Monday**, May 10, and **Tuesday**, May 11, immediately following the weekday Mass or at about **5:55 pm**. In **Bowdle**, we'll have a procession on **Wednesday**, May 12, at **7:00 pm**.

Today, there are lots of different novenas—*novena* coming from the Latin word for *nine*—but the first novena was prayed by the Blessed Mother and the Apostles and other disciples gathered in the upper room where the Last Supper had been celebrated. After the Ascension of Jesus into heaven on Thursday, they continued together for nine days, in prayer for the Gift of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. One of my favorite forms of this novena is the "Novena to the Holy Spirit for the Seven Gifts." The easiest way to find it is probably to just type "seven gifts novena ewtn" into an Internet search. Otherwise, here's a url you can type into the address bar: [ewtn.com/catholicism/devotions/novena-to-the-holy-spirit-for-the-seven-gifts-309](http://ewtn.com/catholicism/devotions/novena-to-the-holy-spirit-for-the-seven-gifts-309) At this address, there's a link to each day's prayers, although they might be listed backwards with Day One at the bottom of the list (you should start with Day One, not Day Nine).

Regardless of which specific prayers you use, please do join in praying during these nine days for a renewed outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon yourself, your family, our parishes, our diocese, even upon the Church throughout the world. The days of the **Novena** run from **Friday, May 14**, to **Saturday, May 22**, the Eve of Pentecost Sunday. May the Fire of the Holy Spirit purify our minds and hearts and spur us on to proclaim with all boldness the saving Gospel of Christ, even as His first Apostles did after Pentecost.
