Just a bit from Fr. Schmidt

First Things First

Going on retreat always brings perspective. It's an especially helpful reminder when our priorities have started to get out of order. "Seek ye first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, then all these things will be given to you besides" (Mt. 6:33). God knows what we need before we ask, but if we aren't desiring above all to receive the Giver Himself, along with the other gifts He knows we need, we "ask wrongly, to spend it on [our] passions" (James 4:3).

God is well aware that even a majority of South Dakota has been experiencing severe to extreme drought conditions. Besides waiting, many have asked what we can do. The spiritual tools at our disposal have not really changed much even since ancient times. Of course, we are to pray. If you haven't been doing at least your daily Rosary, now would be the time to get into the habit. Fasting has always been regarding as a great companion and aid to prayer as well. Wednesdays, Fridays, and Saturdays are the traditional days for fasting in the Christian tradition. You may consider skipping a meal or a dessert or fasting from electronics or media on one or more of those days each week.

Of course we know from Lent that almsgiving and works of mercy complete the list of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Someone once commented to me that one place where God actually tells us to put Him to the test is in the area of almsgiving or tithing (giving a tenth of everything to God). "Bring the full tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. And thereby put me to the test, says the LORD of hosts, if I will not open the windows of heaven for you and pour down for you a blessing until there is no more need" (Malachi 3:10). This doesn't just refer to our contributions to the parish collection, but are there any areas of life where we lack real generosity? If we want God to be generous with us, we need to be generous with Him and with oth-

ers, "for the measure with which you measure will in turn be measured out to you" (Luke 6:38).

These spiritual tools can and should be used throughout the year—not just during Lent, I promise you. Additionally, I'll be leading another Rogation Procession with the Litany of Saints, especially for the intention of blessings of rain, in each parish this week. We'll have one in Hoven on Tuesday, June 29 after the weekday Mass, around 6 pm, and in Bowdle on Thursday, July 1, at 7 pm. Above all, let's renew our thirst for the living God Himself. "As a dry and weary land without water, so my soul is thirsting for you, my God" (Psalm 63:1).
