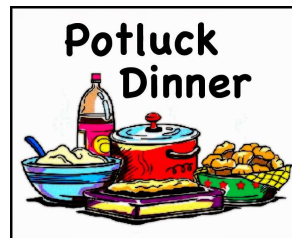

Just a bit from Fr. Schmidt

Fired by God to Shine

I'm glad that temperatures have cooled off a bit recently. Only now, there's probably too much smoke in the air for me to be running outside. I often like to do some reading or my prayers while walking around outside, and in the evenings recently I noticed that as the sun was setting, the bricks of the rectory garage in Hoven would still put off quite a bit of heat as I walked by them. I know bricks have been used for fireplaces and ovens for a long time, but I hadn't really thought much about why that is or the thermodynamics of it.

Archeologists have found evidence that the ability of bricks to absorb energy and then radiate heat at a fairly constant rate for a longer time afterwards has been recognized and used for at least the last 7000 years of human history. During this past week, we also had the reading from Exodus about the shining face of Moses. After conversing with God on Mount Sinai or in the Meeting Tent that housed the Ark of the Covenant, the face of Moses would radiate the light of God's glory for quite some time afterwards. He even started to wear a veil over his shining face because the Israelites had become afraid of him.

Just as bricks radiate the heat of the sun or fire, or like the face of Moses radiating the light of God's glory, Jesus tells His followers, "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden." We are called to radiate the light of God's glory to all the world. Unlike Moses, it's usually not in the form of physical light or phosphorescence, but through the proclamation of the Gospel in word and deed. Each of us is called to tell others about our relationship with Christ and His Presence in the Eucharist and Confession, and to let His light shine out in our actions through the spiritual and corporal works of mercy.

But a brick doesn't get hot by itself. And Moses' face stopped shining when he stayed away from the Ark of the Covenant for too long. We need to regularly spend time in the Presence of God, most especially to visit the Fire of Christ in the tabernacle, to be recharged for the spreading of God's glory through us. He entrusts this matchless Gift of His Body and Blood to His Church, so that you might receive the strength and energy to be a gift to others in your daily living of the Gospel.
