### Just a bit from Fr. Schmidt

#### **The Meal Prayer Before Communion**

This Sunday in Year B of the Lectionary, we start a little break from the Gospel according to St. Mark to focus on the Bread of Life discourse from St. John. It will span the course of several weeks, so one of the challenges for homilists is to avoid saying everything we know about the Most Holy Eucharist on just the first Sunday or two of this series. The Mystery of the Eucharist is no doubt inexhaustible in itself, but what a homilist understands and can express is definitely limited.

During these weeks, I'd like us to start to learn to sing the *Pater Noster* (the Our Father in Latin), one of the parts of the Mass mentioned explicitly in the new Missal that every Catholic is supposed to know how to sing in Latin. In the Pew Missal, the Latin Mass parts start on page 22, and the Pater Noster is on page 27. I'll try to give a reminder at Mass as well. There's also another line that follows the priest's prayer that we'll sing as well: Quia tuum est regnum, et potestas, et gloria in saecula.

The Lord's Prayer has always had a prominent place in the Mass and functions a lot like a meal prayer before the feast of Holy Communion. When I take Communion to the sick or to people in their homes, we always pray the Our Father before they receive the Body of Christ. Being able to pray it in Latin connects us not only geographically with Catholics of different language groups throughout the world today, but also through time to Catholics of previous generations and the Saints, with the very same words that they used to call upon our heavenly Father.

Here's a brief pronunciation guide. Latin actually tends to be easier than English, once you're familiar. Usually,

each vowel can be pronounced with just one sound when singing, rather than the myriad vowel sounds of English. A's are like ah or like the o in Potter. E's, along with ae and oe combos, are pronounced as eh or even like the a in May. I's are like the ee in meek. O's are just the same as we pronounce the letter. U's are like the oo in tool, never preceded by the y sound. So *oculos* is pronounced as OH-koolohs and never OH-kyoo-lohs. C's and G's are given a 'softer' sound when they're followed by I's, E's, ae's and oe's, similar to English, except that C softens from a k to a ch sound rather than an s sound. The sound of T's are softened to a ts sound only when an I and another vowel are the very next letters in the word.
