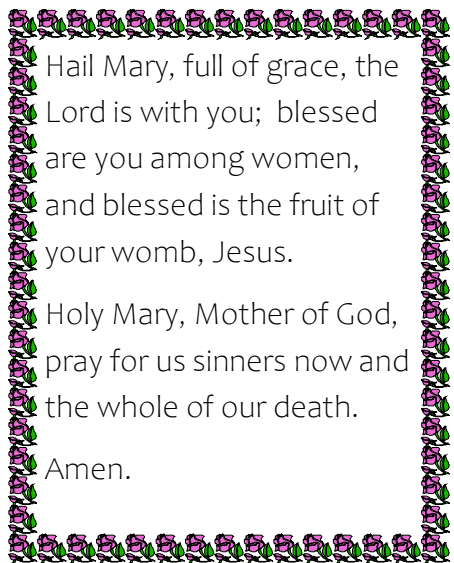

Just a bit from Fr. Schmidt

Rights of the Few Trampled by the Many

Back in Civics class, we learned about the relationship between rights and duties, that the existence of rights implies corresponding duties. In this country, the right to a jury trial implies the corresponding duty of serving on a jury when we are summoned to do so. I've only been summoned for jury duty once, and I was unable to serve due to my being out of the country as a student. Now whether or not trial by jury actually ends up being as impartial as it should be, enjoying this right has long been a point of pride for Americans as an expression of the fairness of our justice system. And even though the right to a jury trial is only ever exercised by a very small minority of our citizens, it should be something we all value, and plenty of people have served on juries even though they've never been on trial themselves.

What's my point? I continue to hear concerns over the use of Latin and chant during a select number of Sundays out of the year. I appreciate the feedback and that some of you are at least voicing these concerns to me directly. I do share the concerns of many, that when we come together to worship God, we have a meaningful experience and know the closeness of God. We also strive to know the communion of saints, to be united not only with others present in the same church at the same Mass but also with Catholics throughout the world and indeed with Catholics throughout time, back through the centuries.

One way the Roman Catholic Church has expressed this unity is through the use of the very same words of the very same prayers, even joined to the very same melodies, many dating back at least to the time of Pope St. Gregory the Great, who died in the year 604. The Catholic faithful have a right to Catholic liturgy—which includes giving Gregorian chant pride of place, as both the Second Vatican Council and the current Roman Missal explicitly call for. Catholic clergy have the corresponding duty to provide the faithful with Catholic liturgy.

And even if only a minority of the faithful have an interest in experiencing Latin and chant in the Church's liturgy (even as only a small minority of citizens ever exercise their right for a jury trial), as a Catholic priest I have a duty to honor that right. I cannot disregard the rights of each and of all, for the sake of the preferences even of the majority. And so, I don't think it unreasonable to actually give Gregorian chant some place on certain Sundays out of the year, especially considering that the majority of Sundays are still almost entirely in English, apart from *A mens* and *Alleluias*. What do you think? Let me hear from you.
