# Just a bit from Fr. Schmidt

#### **Time to Grow Accustomed**

Back in my first days and weeks of the priesthood, I faced a lot of changes. I was moving back from Rome for ordination in late June, starting my first assignment only about a week later, celebrating Mass and preaching daily for the first time. And my first assignment had unique adjustments of its own. Fr. Cimpl was moving there as the new pastor at the same time, and the church was still being renovated, so we were saying Mass in the gym and using the youth room as a sacristy.

That's all to say that I'm very grateful to Fr. Cimpl and the staff and so many parishioners there that still made it a very smooth transition and allowed me to concentrate mainly on just praying the Mass and settling in. It was during my time there at Holy Spirit in Sioux Falls that I became more acquainted with the Church's vision for how the Mass should be celebrated as a participation in the worship offered constantly by the Angels and Saints in heaven, which goes beyond anything you or I or anyone has personally experienced in any parish or chapel.

One thing that became really clear is the importance placed on Gregorian chant, which is to be given "pride of place" because it is proper to the Roman Liturgy." Even to me and other priests, all the reasons or spiritual benefits of chant and specifically chanting the Latin parts and propers of the Mass are not immediately apparent. Most of us had much of the same experience growing up, preferring English hymns. I found personally that I had to have a chant almost to the point of being memorized before I could really appreciate its beauty and pray it in a powerful way.

Things that are new to us don't usually feel natural right away, so please be patient, be open, and trust the wisdom of the Church's norms as we continue to try to sing the Latin Our Father. Here's a word-for-word translation, if that might help. Notice that Latin relies more on the endings of words to show their function in the sentence rather than relying as much on word order.

Pater (Father) noster (our) qui (who) es (are) in (in) caelis (the heavens), sanctificétur (be made holy) nomen (name) tuum (your), advéniat (let it arrive/come) regnum (kingdom/reign) tuum (your), *fiat* (let it be done) *volúntas* (will/volition) tua (your), sicut (as it is) in (in) caelo (heaven) et (so also) in (on) terra (earth). Panem (bread) nostrum (our) cotidiánum (daily) da (give) nobis (to us) *hódie* (today) *et* (and) *dimítte* (dismiss/ forgive) nobis (from us) débita (debts/sins) nostra (our) sicut (as) et (also) nos (we) dimíttimus (dismiss/forgive) debitóribus (debtors) nostris (our), et (and) ne (do not) nos (us) indúcas (lead) in (into) tentationem (testing/temptation), sed (but) *libera* (free/liberate) *nos* (us) *a* (from) *malo* (evil)...Quia (for/because) tuum (yours) est (is) regnum (the kingdom/reign) et (and) potéstas (the power) et (and) glória (the glory) in (into) saécula (the ages/forever).
