Vocations and Synod

There are a few events coming up of special note. From the Vocations Office, there will be what's called an **Operation Andrew Dinner** (named for St. Peter's brother, who brought him to Jesus) **at the NSU Newman Center on Tuesday, February 1 at 6 pm**. It's an opportunity to have supper with Bishop DeGrood, Fr. Samson (the Vocations Director) and area priests to discuss and hear about discerning a vocation to the priesthood. It's not a commitment in any way to join or apply to the seminary, but it's very low-key. If you know of any **young men in high school** in our parishes who would or should be interested in attending and can fit that into their schedules, please try to let me know by this Wednesday so that I can get them signed up.

The other Vocations event is for **men ages 18-24** to actually visit and stay overnight at **St. John Vianney Seminary**, where I went to college at the University of St. Thomas in St. Paul, MN. The Vianney Visit will be from **Thursday, February 17 to Saturday, February 19**. Carpooling will be available from Aberdeen. Fr. Michael Kapperman is planning to drive from there.

Besides Vocations events for men concerning the priesthood, there have been visits to houses of religious sisters and nuns, so I'll be sure to pass on word of anything in the works, and any young women who might have an interest can let me know so we can coordinate with other parishes.

The other event already underway in many places is called the **Synod on Synodality**, called for by Rome, taking place on a diocesan level till later this year, culminating in a worldwide Synod of Bishops in 2023. A synod is basically an official meeting of the Church that's usually more local than an ecumenical council. There have been diocesan and regional synods many times before. As the Church in the United States was starting out, there were often synods in Baltimore, which was the first diocese in the USA.

The emphasis of this Synod is on listening, and so the main method of participation will be to respond to a survey. The questions of the survey are already available for review on the diocesan website, along with other links and resources concerning the Synod on Synodality: www.sfcatholic.org/synod/ Responses to the survey can be submitted starting on **February 1**. Please encourage as many people as possible to take the survey. Even non-Catholics can do so, as far as I know.
