The Time Has Come

Here’s hoping that Lent will live up to its name (which comes from a word for the “spring” season) and bring some warmer weather and rain. If not, we’ll have a bit more penance to offer up, anyway. As we reach Ash Wednesday this week, hopefully you’ve given some thought and prayer to what God would like you to do in the areas of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving during the Lenten season this year. I’ve always found that having a regular practice of voluntary, freely-chosen penance on Wednesdays, Fridays, and other days—even throughout the year, to actively “take up your cross daily and follow” Jesus (Lk. 9:23)—makes it much easier for me to have more patience when it comes to other trials and crosses that I encounter unwillingly, unchosen and unlooked for.

One practice that the Church highly recommends is to make more visits to Jesus, present in the tabernacles of our churches. For those who spend half an hour in adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, the Church even provides a plenary indulgence, obtainable every day of the year under the usual conditions. **Adoration** is also distinct from exposition, so it’s not necessary for Jesus to be in a monstrance outside the tabernacle (which is called *exposition*) to obtain this indulgence or the other graces of visiting His Eucharistic Presence. Visiting any Catholic church and praying to Jesus inside the tabernacle is an act of adoration, and Jesus is sure to repay the visit with gifts of His strength and grace in those moments we most need Him.

Last year, I tried to have **40 Hours Devotion** (40 hours of continuous exposition of the Blessed Sacrament) during a couple of the more solemn Feasts after Easter. But I think it worked better two years ago to have it during Lent, when people are looking for more opportunities to pray and before summer activities. I’m planning on the weekend of **March 26-27 for Bowdle** and **April 2-3 for Hoven**. As in previous years, each will begin with the Saturday morning Latin Mass at **6 am** followed by Exposition until **10 pm** on Sunday, with Compline and Benediction shortly before, making Saturday to Sunday the only overnight hours. Again, the most crucial hours to sign up for and fill will be the times when I’ll be celebrating Mass in the other parish. I hope you’ll have the opportunity.
