## Just a bit from Fr. Schmidt

#### **Synod Survey & Marian Antiphons**

The survey that the Diocese has prepared for participation in the Synod on Synodality is now available, and they've been receiving completed surveys since February 1. Please find and complete your survey at <a href="www.sfcatholic.org">www.sfcatholic.org</a> and encourage others to do so.

I did have supper with the Bishop and with several other priests of the area this past Monday. The conversation seemed centered around how to get parishioners to take more ownership of things like maintenance of the physical structures of the parish, religious education programs, etc., especially as we face a lot of priest retirements in these next years. I'm thankful for everyone who works and volunteers at our parishes to help things run smoothly and keep our churches and cemeteries clean and in working order.

If you attend any weekday Masses, you may have noticed that about once a week as a post-Communion meditation, I use one of four Marian Antiphons. Since at least the 13<sup>th</sup> century, these prayers have been sung as the conclusion to Compline at the end of each day by priests, religious, and anyone who prays the Liturgy of the Hours. The one used during the time after Pentecost is the most familiar: the Hail Holy Queen (Salve Regina), usually concluding the Rosary as well. The Regina Coeli is also familiar to many, often used in place of the Angelus prayers during the Easter season.

The other two are probably not very familiar to most. From the beginning of Advent until February 1, the Alma Redemptoris Mater is used, and from February 2 to the end of Lent it's the Ave Regina Caelorum. Each is a beautiful prayer to our Blessed Mother.

Alma Redemptoris Mater in translation: Nourishing Mother of the Redeemer, who remain the open gate of heaven and the star of the sea, help your falling people who want to rise: You who gave birth to your holy Sire while nature marveled, a Virgin before and after, receiving that "Ave" from Gabriel's mouth, have pity on us sin-

Ave Regina Caelorum in translation:

Hail, Queen of the heavens, hail Lady of Angels: Hail root, hail gate, from which Light has risen for the world:

Rejoice, glorious Virgin, splendid above all: Farewell, O exceedingly elegant one, and beseech Christ for us.
