Lectors and Mail Delays

I hope everyone's had a good start to Lent. I often hear the reminder that it's not a sprint but a marathon. Strive for consistency, but don't get discouraged when not everything goes perfectly. Too often when we find ourselves falling short of perfection in our Lenten observances, we just give it up entirely. Each new day is a new opportunity to express our love for God and for the people around us, to take up our cross and follow Christ.

The month of March is dedicated especially to St. Joseph, the Husband of Mary, as his Solemnity occurs on March 19. The focus of our **March Catechesis** will be on **St. Joseph, Universal Patron**. We'll look at both the Biblical foundations of devotion to him and its history in the life of the Church. I've always personally had a devotion to St. Joseph as the patron of my home parish in Elk Point and the patron of the Diocese of Sioux Falls.

I'd also like to find a time in the next month or so to have some **Lector Training**, and my schedule is flexible, so if there's someone willing to serve the parish as a reader at Mass, we'll find a time that works for you. With two Sunday Masses in Hoven and even just with one in Bowdle, the lectors already serving in both parishes seem to come up in the rotation quite often, so it would be a great help to get more on the list. Anyone who has had their Confirmation can serve as a lector, including students still in high school. If there's anyone you know who can read and who you think would do a good job read-

ing at Mass, let them know and let me know, and we'll see about getting them trained and on the schedule. Have in mind as well that lectors can always ask me about pronunciation of words that come up in the Lectionary. I know there are some strange ones and weird names.

Earlier this week, I attended a deanery meeting with the other area priests. They all report delays in parishioners receiving their CFSA pledge cards. The leading theory is delays in the mail service, so please be patient and know that yours aren't the only ones arriving late. Your patience, generosity, and prayers for this year's appeal are greatly appreciated.
