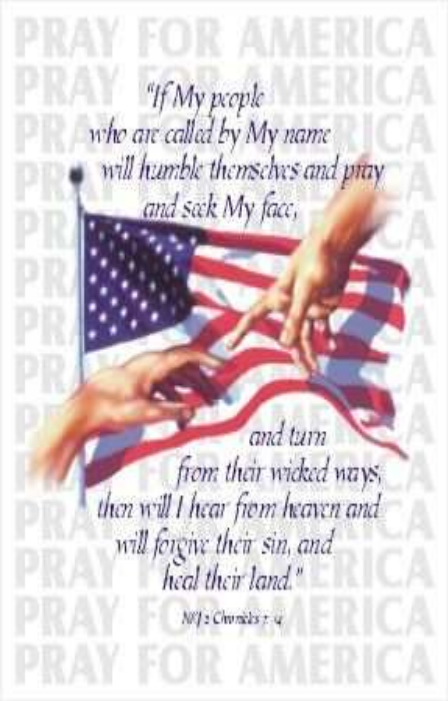

Varied Reactions to Great News

We have more to celebrate than usual this Independence Day with the recent overturning of Roe v. Wade. Just think of all the prayers, marches, letters, and conversations over these decades that have contributed and led to this important step in the rebuilding of a culture of life and protection under the law of every innocent human being, from conception to natural death. Of course, there are still many States and areas of our country that allow the slaughter of innocents to continue, and many hearts and minds remain unconverted, so the work is far from over. Even in places where abortion is now illegal, the fostering of compassion, true charity, and peace requires a continually renewed effort and vigilance.

As great as this new Supreme Court ruling is, we know all too well that not everyone is rejoicing about it. Some have even reacted with anger and violence. The level of devotion that so many in our government and in our culture seem to have has been compared to the "religious" zeal of those who served the false god Moloch in the history of Israel. “And they poured out innocent blood, blood of their sons and of their daughters, which they immolated to the idols of Canaan, and the land was polluted with bloods” (Ps. 106:38). For many, abortion is treated as a sort of "sacrament," representing for them causes like women’s "liberation" and the sexual revolution, along with technological mastery over (and rejection of) nature and natural consequences.

I’m not sure about you, but I remain skeptical that the direction a lot of things have gone in recent human history is towards much of anything that could be reasonably characterized as "progress," at least when it comes to how people tend to treat one another.

What has the power to break such a demonic hold over the minds and hearts of so many? Only the Most Precious Blood of Christ, which washes away our sins and the sins of the whole world. The month of July is especially dedicated to the Precious Blood. As we celebrate the 4th with renewed patriotism and thanksgiving to live in this great land, please join me in continuing to beg God’s mercy and purification upon our country and upon all who live here, through the Precious Blood poured out for our salvation.
