Just a bit from Fr. Schmidt

Eucharistic Revival

The Feast of Corpus Christi this Sunday is the start of a National Eucharistic Revival. This next year will be the diocesan phase, culminating at Corpus Christi of 2023. The parochial, parish phase will then begin and continue throughout that year until the National Eucharistic Congress to be held in Indianapolis in 2024. The following year will be a year of mission and outreach until the Feast of Pentecost 2025. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops have launched a website for this Eucharistic Revival where you can sign up to receive e-mail updates and reflections or to join the campaign of prayer and penance: eucharisticrevival.org.

Many popes and theologians have reflected on the fact that the Church founded by Christ upon the Apostles is a Eucharistic Church by her very essence. From the very beginning, Christians devoted themselves to “the Apostles’ teaching and fellowship, the breaking of the bread and the prayers” (Acts 2:42). Without the Eucharist, we would not be the Church. We would not be the members of Christ’s Mystical Body that we are meant to be without this memorial of His one perfect sacrifice on Calvary and without the nourishment we receive from His own Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity.

One thing that other priests and parishioners have brought up recently is just how detrimental the COVID lockdowns were in the faith lives of many Catholics and how lasting those effects have been. When churches were closed and the Sunday obligation was dispensed, people were understandably encouraged to watch recordings or streamed celebrations of the Mass to stay connected virtually, but God doesn’t want a merely virtual relationship with us. God also wants more for our relationship with the Church and her other members, including and perhaps especially all the ways in which physically getting ourselves and our little ones into the church for Mass and having to put up with each other can be a challenge but also a blessing that escapes our own comprehension.

When someone is legitimately impeded from fulfilling their Sunday obligation by illness or disability or the need to actively care for another in such a condition, it’s certainly a great blessing when they can tune in to the Bishop’s Mass or other virtual opportunities, but virtual “participation” is not and never was a different way of fulfilling the same obligation to assist at Sunday Mass. If that misconception still persists among Catholics, then renewing our commitment to actual attendance at the Sunday Eucharist seems like a necessary first step in our Eucharistic Revival.
