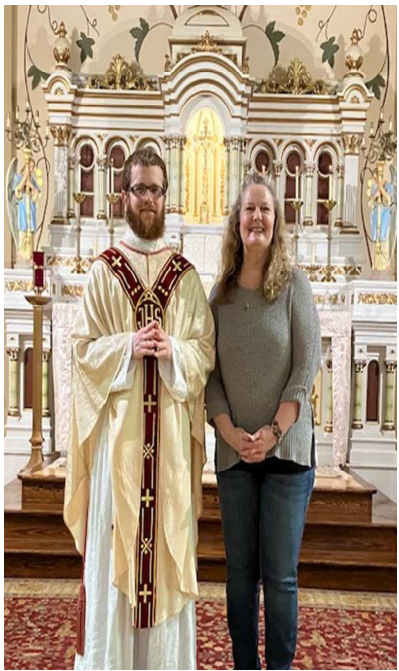

Just a bit from Fr. Schmidt

Patrons on My Rebirthday

As a priest or someone who was studying for the priesthood for most of my adult life, I've served as a baptismal sponsor just a few times. But I've made it a point to pray for my godchildren and to celebrate especially the anniversary of their baptism each year, or what I've called their *Rebirthday*. Our supernatural birth from the waters of the baptismal font—the moment we became sons and daughters of God, members of the Body of Christ in His Church, and temples of the Holy Spirit—was a much more significant event than even our natural birth, though hopefully much less of an ordeal for our mothers.

Not everyone knows or celebrates their Rebirthday, but I think I learned mine before being confirmed and have celebrated it since then. The date has held additional significance for me since my ordination to the priesthood happened to fall on the same day: June 26. This Sunday is my 7th anniversary of ordination and my 34th of baptism. More recently I've come to appreciate the Saints that have historically been celebrated on June 26: Sts. John and Paul, who are mentioned in the Roman Canon or Eucharistic Prayer I.

Sts. John and Paul were faithful servants of the daughter of Emperor Constantine, who legalized Christianity in the Roman Empire. However, not every ruler that came after Constantine would maintain the same stance towards the Christian religion. When Julian came to the throne, whom history remembers as Julian the Apostate (an *apostate* is someone who has completely renounced the Faith), he offered John and Paul a promotion. They would no longer just serve an emperor's daughter but Emperor Julian himself if they would renounce Christianity and serve the old Roman idols. After ten days given them to consider the offer, they still refused and offered their heads in witness to Christ, the King who reigns higher than any earthly emperor.

More recently, June 26 has also become the feastday of **St Josemaría Escrivá**, founder of Opus Dei and often named the Saint of Ordinary Life. A great apostle of the universal call to holiness, St Josemaría is best known for his very practical advice for lay faithful and clergy alike to live the virtues and pursue a life of communion with God through the work and concrete circumstances of our everyday lives. God has called us to holiness not in spite of the many tasks that fill up our day, but precisely *through* the graced performance of our daily duties, to offer the prayers, works, joys, and sufferings of each day and our very selves “as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God” (Rom. 12:1).
