Month of the Sacred Heart

On Memorial Day, I took a longer bike ride, from Hoven to Bowdle and back again, for the first time this year and with a new seat. Even with a bit of rain in the afternoon and tiring at certain points, it was enjoyable. I'm often amazed at how many different views of large expanses of land there are just in the few miles we traverse rather quickly in our cars. And the peaceful scenes of fields and flocks help the noise of world events and so many things I can't control seem farther away.

I hope we all find opportunities this summer not just for more activities and rapid travel but also for silence, stillness, prayer, and contemplation. First and foremost, the Holy Spirit desires to teach us to pray and to live in communion with the Father and the Son. There is certainly a lot to do this time of year, but I also know how often I fill my time with other things and keep myself "busy" almost as a way of *avoiding* prayer and intimacy with God. The Catechism quotes St. Alphonsus Liguori as saying, "Those who pray are certainly saved. Those who do not pray are certainly damned."

If we are too busy to pray, then we really are *too busy*. June is the month dedicated especially to the **Most Sacred Heart of Jesus**. Throughout His life and most especially as He hung upon the Cross for us, the Heart of Jesus was opened to us. It remains open through the wound in His side if we will open ourselves up to Him. In the visions of the Sacred Heart that St. Margaret Mary had, Jesus expressed His great grief, that after loving us so fully, pouring out every last drop of His Precious Blood for us, we are so half-hearted and stingy in our response.

Jesus longs for you, He longs for me, with a love that is unique. And He desires our unique response. No one else can do it for you. No one can take your place in His Heart. He waits for you. In the tabernacle, He waits for you to visit. Let's not keep Him waiting and grieved at our indifference but strive to serve Him with all our heart, even as He has loved us, with all that is His. His Heart is yours. Will you not give Him your heart in return?
