

The Brown Scapular

The scapular of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, also known as the Brown scapular, is one of the most popular and celebrated of Roman Catholic devotions. The sacramental as the lay faithful commonly use it is a miniature derivative of the actual brown scapular used by the Carmelites –the sleeveless outer garment falling from the shoulders which is worn as a sign of their vocation and devotion.



As was mentioned, Our Lady gave St. Simon a scapular for the Carmelites with the following promise, saying : "Receive, My beloved son, this habit of thy order: this shall be to thee and to all Carmelites a privilege, that whosoever dies clothed in this shall never suffer eternal fire It shall be a sign of salvation, a protection in danger, and a pledge of peace."

New Resident Priest

Back when new priest assignments were being announced this past spring, most of which took effect last week-end, I mentioned that while my own assignment has not changed, there was a possibility of another priest moving into one of the rectories here. That priest is Fr. Timothy Smith, the former pastor of Ipswich, Leola, and Roscoe, who has moved into the Bowdle Rectory and will be a full-time student in the canon law program in Ottawa, Ontario.

Since it's possible now to take a lot of the classes remotely, Fr. Smith will be living in Bowdle as he does so. When he's not studying, he'll also be providing substitute Mass coverage in different parishes, so you might not actually see him around too often in these parishes. I just wanted to give an update for those who have seen other vehicles around or even some movement of furniture. Fr. Smith and I both lived at the Cathedral in Sioux Falls for his first two years of the priesthood, and we've been neighbors up here since then, so we're already familiar with how we each live. If you do see him around, be sure to welcome him.

Besides the logistics of moving, there's also probably the more difficult process of good-byes and of introductions to a whole new set of people. In the weeks and months ahead, please offer some prayers for the priests in new assignments and for the parishes and communities receiving them. As with most things in life, change can be good but also difficult, even as stability and consistency have their own advantages and limitations. Pray that God's will can be accomplished for all involved throughout our diocese as we all continue to strive for *lifelong Catholic missionary discipleship through God's love*.

I hope everyone's summer is going well. I saw some great fireworks over the weekend of the 4th and got to relax and have some fun at my brother's house in Aberdeen on Monday. At my first assignment, Fr. Chuck Cimpr would always lament that the 4th of July meant that summer was almost over. I'm still hoping that's not the case and that he mostly felt that way because of the number of meetings he had about tuition assistance leading into the fall semester for the Catholic schools. But with each passing year, the time does seem to go by more quickly, so enjoy the sunshine whenever you have the chance!
