Just a bit from Fr. Schmidt

One, Two, Three, or.. Four Marys?

Some changes to the liturgical calendar in recent years have brought to mind some interesting questions that the text of Scripture tends to leave unanswered. The first change Pope Francis made to July's calendar of feasts was to raise **St. Mary Magdalene's** from the rank of Memorial to Feast, which involves adding the Gloria to the celebration of Mass on July 22, along with her own proper Preface (preceding the Sanctus). The new Preface mentions her traditional title of "apostle to the Apostles," alluding to the appearance Jesus makes to her at the tomb after His Resurrection and his sending her (*apostle* means "one sent") to report to the Eleven His rising from the dead.

This renewed emphasis of the importance of the Magdalene's role as one of the first chosen witnesses of the Resurrection does not rule out, however, the Church's long and beautiful tradition that the very first appearance Jesus made after His Resurrection was to His own Mother. Though it isn't recorded in Scripture, it would explain why Mary, the Mother of God, was not among the women who went to the tomb on Easter morning, not only because of her faith in her Son's earlier predictions of His Resurrection, but also because He had already appeared to her. No doubt Jesus was even more eager than any loving, grateful, and dutiful Son to console and bring joy to this Mother who had so grievously suffered with Him in witnessing His Passion, death, and burial.

The other more recent change to the calendar involved adding the siblings of St. Martha to her feastday on July 29. Now celebrated as a family unit, the letter that accompanied the promulgation of the Memorial of **Sts. Martha, Mary, and Lazarus** of Bethany seemed to imply that the change was at least partially motivated by "advances" in Biblical studies that have now made it clear that Mary Magdalene and Mary of Bethany are not the same person. I remain unconvinced, and it's not any real problem for a Saint to have more than one feast on the calendar either way.

We just heard about Martha and Mary in last Sunday's Gospel from St. Luke, and St. John tells us also about their brother Lazarus whom Jesus raises from the dead. St. Gregory the Great is the one who most famously identifies Mary Magdalene with Mary of Bethany, along with the woman caught in adultery in John 8 and the sinful woman who anoints Jesus' feet in Luke 7. Personally, I find it very beautiful and consoling to consider that the same woman from whom Jesus cast out seven demons would become the great contemplative we witness in Mary of Bethany. Or you might think the two, three, or all four are distinctly different women. Regardless, may God grant that we would benefit from the intercession and example of such great siblings and Saints.
