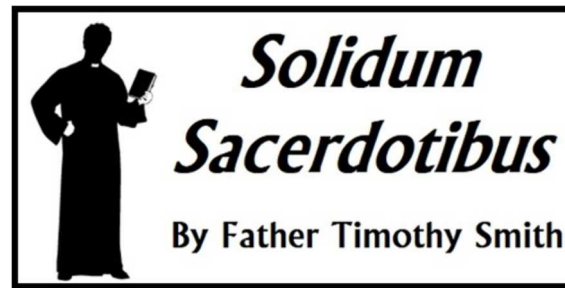

Thank you for your generous church support!



My name is Father Timothy Smith and I am the priest who is living at Saint Augustine parish in Bowdle while I study for a Licentiate in Canon Law for the Catholic Church Legal System which is headquartered at the Apostolic Tribunal of the Roman Rota in Vatican City. You might wonder how this is at all possible? I will take instruction remotely through classes and information available online. Over the past decade, specialized training for priests has become more widely available. I am part of a class of 20 students who all are studying to become canon lawyers in the Catholic Church. The school where our professors are teaching from is Saint Paul's University in Ottawa, Canada. In my class group, 15 of us are studying remotely online in places all across the country. I have always admired families who have decided to take on the challenge of a homeschooling education. With the decision by Bishop DeGrood, I am now officially a homeschool priest! My classes begin the first week of September.

The Catholic Church has a complete legal system, which is the oldest in Western Civilization that is still in use. My full time job is to learn all of church law, understand it in terms of its theological, philosophical, and historical background, and learn the method and practice to serve the church in South Dakota. I will take classes covering major sections of the Code of Canon Law. I will also take introductory courses in ecclesiastical Latin, which is the official language of the Catholic Church. I volunteered for this responsibility because I know how important it is to equip our church in South Dakota with priests who have the proper credentials to conduct church business.

You might wonder if this will cost your parish any money. The answer is NO. All of my expenses are paid for by the Bishop and the Diocese of Sioux Falls. Father Darin Schmidt is still your Pastor and makes all the decisions in your parish. You will see me around once in a while, but I am not available for visits due to my busy school schedule and workload. For recreation I hunt ducks & geese in the fall, winter, and spring. I fish in the summer. I now only eat meat, fish, cheese, and a few other kinds of vegetables. The best food gift for me is steak, which is a good thing because I love our South Dakota farmers and ranchers!
