

Just a bit from Fr. Schmidt

Even Unto Death

Because August 15 is on a Monday, it is not a holy day of obligation this year in the United States. As such, we'll just have the regular 5:15pm Mass in Hoven as on other Mondays. I hope that many will still be able to join us in celebrating the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, body and soul, into heavenly glory.

Each year, some of the same ideas about this mystery come to mind, whether they were points emphasized by my theology professors while I was in seminary, things I've read, or topics of regular meditation in praying the Glorious Mysteries of the Rosary. One thing my professors were careful to point out is that when Pope Pius XII defined the dogma of Mary's bodily Assumption in 1950, he was careful to leave open the question of whether or not Mary died and experienced the separation of soul and body for any length of time by using the phrase instead: "having completed the course of her earthly life."

From this I was led to believe that either opinion is equally valid: either that Mary did not die but was translated in an instant from her earthly existence into the possession of her heavenly, glorified body, or that she did die before being raised to eternal life in Christ. What all Catholics do believe on this question is that human death is a consequence of sin, and because Mary was immaculately conceived without original sin and committed no sin throughout her life, she was not subject to death as the rest of us are. That she did not personally *need* to experience death as any consequence of sin is clear.

So the question is whether she freely accepted death anyway, to be more closely conformed to Christ her Son, who freely accepted death for our salvation. What I found as I looked more into it this year is that all the Church Fathers that Pius XII

quotes, and really any of the Fathers that talked about Mary's Assumption, took for granted that she did in fact die and was buried before rising again to heavenly glo-

I find it comforting that the only two people exempt from death both freely accepted and experienced it—the One, in order to trample our own death under His feet the other, to be more perfectly conformed to the Image and saving mysteries of Him who is our Life and Resurrection, thereby also drawing compassionately closer to the experience of us sinners. May she who did not fear to die, though she had done nothing to deserve it, intercede for us who chafe against the consequences of our own sins.
