

Just a bit from Fr. Schmidt

Doctor of Grace

It's not too often that the Feast of St. Augustine falls on a Sunday, and even when it does, the Sunday usually outranks it. The one exception is when he's the Patron of a parish or a diocese, so I'm excited to celebrate his feast at St. Augustine in Bowdle on the same day we're having our Parish Picnic. St. Augustine was the name I chose when I received Confirmation, mostly because the story of his conversion, which has touched countless lives over the centuries through his *Confessions*, his quest for peace and truth that led him out of sin and error.

Sadly, not many Catholics today know much about St. Augustine, who was one of the most prolific writers in the early Church, Bishop of Hippo in North Africa, baptized by St. Ambrose of Milan, another Doctor of the Church. St. Augustine is known as the **Doctor of Grace** for his writings against the Donatists and Pelagians of his day. Donatists taught that sinful ministers could not celebrate valid sacraments, but Augustine with the rest of the Church has always taught that Jesus Christ—who is Himself the true High Priest whenever His sacraments are celebrated—still accomplishes the saving work of His grace even through imperfect instruments, the clergy he calls upon to continue His own sacred ministry in the Church of every age down to our own day.

Pelagians taught that the sin passed on from Adam and Eve affects us mostly by bad example and that we still have it within our human nature to do good and overcome sinful vices, even without the help of God's supernatural grace. Augustine with the rest of the Church has always taught instead that Original Sin has

affected all of us in profound ways, darkening our intellect and weakening our will. As St. Paul emphasizes in his letters in the New Testament, it is only by the free gift of God's grace that we can turn away from sin and grow in virtue. Our love for God is always a *response* to Him, who has already been seeking us and moving us by His grace. "We love because He first loved us" (1 Jn 4:19).

The Church now celebrates the mother of St. Augustine on the previous day, August 27. Another great Saint and model of persevering intercession, **St. Monica** prayed for decades with many tears and cries to God to finally see the conversion of her husband Patricius before he died, and the conversion of her son Augustine, wayward and wandering for most of his early life. May St. Monica and St. Augustine pray for all wandering souls and those who long for their return to God.
