Just a bit from Fr. Schmidt

Home Improvement, Travels, Confirmation & Assumption

We've had some higher temperatures this past week, but during the week prior you may have even seen me out on the roof of the rectory in Hoven or Fr. Smith finishing out the fence on the alley side of the rectory in Bowdle. He uses the grill more than I do, so I'm glad he's been able to make that area more comfortable. In Hoven, I was addressing the problems we've had with the awning over the front door of the office and rectory. I'm hopeful that at least that tile in front of the door will stay dry now, but the piece of clear plexiglass I found in the garage is only able to cover the first three feet or so. If anyone has some bigger pieces left over from COVID measures or things like that, please let me know.

On August 11 in Sioux Falls, I'll be joining the Bishop and the other priests and deacons for different meetings and presentations during the day and for burgers and brats at the Bishop's house in the afternoon. It's our **annual fall workshop**. To make the drive more worthwhile, I'll be taking off after Mass on Monday morning and returning sometime on Friday. I'll probably see my parents in Elk Point and the family of my sister who lives outside Sioux Falls.

We've also received word from the Bishop's Office that His Excellency Bishop DeGrood is planning to come to Hoven next summer on **June 10** to celebrate the **Sacrament of Confirmation** for both St. Augustine and St. Anthony Parishes. Please mark your calendars and be in contact with our religious education coordinators if you have children preparing and desiring to receive this sacrament next year.

The month of August honors the **Immaculate Heart of Mary** and has at its center the oldest Feast of the Blessed Mother, the first feast of hers kept on the calendar as an annual celebration, that of her bodily **Assumption** into heaven. Known in the East as the Dormition or falling asleep, I found out—back when I was Bishop Swain's Master of Ceremonies and researching things like Church Dedications—that for parishes named St. Mary or not having a more specific title of hers with a feast on the calendar, August 15 was kept as their Patronal Feastday, so be sure to wish anyone named after the Blessed Mother a happy Namesday on that Feast as well.

More Mass Intentions are needed for Hoven for weekday Masses. The suggested donation is \$10 per Mass Intention. You may call Melissa at the office to see what is available or drop a note in the collection basket.
