Just a bit from Fr. Schmidt

Set Ablaze

Throughout the diocese this weekend we'll be announcing to be on the lookout for an email from the Bishop or his Chancery offices during this upcoming week. As I've mentioned before, even before our previous Bishop Paul Swain retired, he had said that another round of pastoral planning was already becoming a pressing need. I also pointed out back in May when I attended the ordinations in Sioux Falls that it could be a few years before we ordain new priests again. Please continue to pray for vocations and for the health of our parishes and families as the seedbeds of vocations.

Now that Bishop DeGrood has had a chance to get acclimated to our diocese and to visit many of our parishes and faithful, he has been in consultation with many different people and groups about what the next phase of pastoral planning will look like. The communications you should receive this week will highlight census data, trends, and what we've been able to observe as parishes and as a diocese regarding growth or lack of growth in Catholic practice, even as the total population of east-river South Dakota continues to rise.

The various facts and raw data have been examined and summarized into what you will hopefully find to be understandable forms: maps, graphs, tables, and charts as part of a "Current Reality Report." Anyone who does not have a working email address currently on file or who has trouble accessing this report and the website that will

be published can please contact me or someone else you know who has some computer savvy to be able to see these. If there is interest in doing so as a group, perhaps in the church basement or in the office, we could arrange for that as well.

This first part of the process is just about taking some time to see and digest where we are at and the way things have been trending for Catholic practice over the past decade or so, in relation to total population and other census data, and to understand what resources we have and can reasonably count on as a diocese for the next ten years in relation to the needs and demands within the diocese, and the health of our clergy. The overall process is being titled **Set Ablaze**, as we look to use this as an opportunity for revitalization and for interrupting the downward trends through a renewed fire for God and for His Church here on the prairie.
