Just a bit from Fr. Schmidt

Adult Catechesis

Earlier this week, I saw someone correcting Ascension Press for saying that the 1994/1997 *Catechism of the Catholic Church* is the second most important book in the Catholic Church. My own view is that the second most important book must be one of the four Gospel accounts. The Bible itself is not really just one book, but a collection of 73 books (72, if Jeremiah and Lamentations are counted as one). Maybe that sounds ex-
cessively precise, but it is important to keep in mind that the books of the Bible had various human authors who wrote in different places, languages, and at different points in time during the long history of Israel and the beginnings of the Church founded by Christ upon the Apostles.

But whether the Catechism is the 74th most important book or a little lower on the list, it remains a very use-
ful summary of Catholic doctrine today. I often mention that reading through it in its entirety as a sopho-
more in high school was an important moment in my own discernment of a vocation to the priesthood and
taking personal ownership of my faith and life as a Catholic.

This year for Adult Catechesis, I'll be working through the Catechism with a few people preparing to enter
into the full communion of the Catholic Church or to receive the sacrament of Confirmation later in life. We
will begin classes in the **Hoven church basement** on **Tuesdays at 10 am** beginning this Tuesday, October 18.
Anyone is welcome to attend, and if you know of any others interested in joining the Church or any adult
Catholics still needing to receive the sacrament of Confirmation, please help them get in contact with me. If
this time does not work for others, we can find other times to meet in addition. Another candidate will start
classes at a later time after he completes more marriage preparation, and those classes may be offered in
Bowdle. I will announce times and locations
as they begin.

If there are any other Bible studies or video
series that groups are interested in using and
discussing together at other times, the church
basements can be made available. Both parish
halls are now equipped with wireless Internet,
St. Augustine's just recently thanks to Rocky
getting it set up right before his retirement.
God's blessings upon you and your families
this upcoming week, as you also take a look at
the new plan for the restructuring of our dio-
cese and pastoral planning.
