Just a bit from Fr. Schmidt

Parish Clusters

If you've seen the maps depicting the new pastorates and linked parishes, you can start to understand how big of a change is coming not just to the parishes here but throughout the Diocese. Besides the increased number of parishes clustered or linked together under the pastoral care of one or up to four priests, one of the other main changes under this structure is that each pastorate, each of the circles, will have just one priest designated as pastor for all the parishes in that area. The idea is that having a smaller number of pastors more skilled or willing to engage in more of the administrative tasks of parish life will free up the other priests for greater efforts in evangelization, teaching, spiritual and liturgical formation, home visits, etc.

A lot of the practicalities in each pastorate will start to be worked out once they are implemented next July, including, for example, local discussions of how best to allocate the number of weekend Masses recommended based on the size and attendance in each church and the number of priests in each pastorate. At this early stage, the Diocese is mainly just looking for feedback about the configuration of the pastorates (the circles), whether it makes more sense for Bowdle to be grouped with Ipswich or Mobridge, for example.

One change that I've already witnessed since these were shown to the priests and deacons on August 11 is that Hoven and Gettysburg were originally grouped with Mobridge rather than Pierre. So there could be a few more edits based on feedback before the finalized configuration is confirmed and released. Keep in mind that the goal is to set us up to be in a good place throughout the Diocese for the number of priests we'll expect to have in 2032, along with some flexibility for contingencies and to keep our priests healthy, happy, and holy.

However it all shakes out, it's clear that greater collaboration between parishes is expected, along with relying less

upon the priests for certain things that can be handled by volunteers or staff. One area that comes to mind is having at least a few different people trained as sacristans to set up for Mass and as organists to lead the choir. Parish funds are available to pay for piano/organ lessons for anyone willing and having some aptitude. Above all, continue to pray for holy priestly vocations.
