Octave of Cemetery Indulgences

You are no doubt aware that the name *Halloween* comes from *All Hallows' Eve*, being the day before All Saints' Day. Please check the Mass times and locations for All Saints' as it is a holy day of obligation. Mass times are also listed for All Souls' Day, on which Fr. Smith and I will each be celebrating three Masses. A Mass of Remembrance, offered especially for those of our parishes who died during this past year, will also be celebrated in each parish: 7:00 pm on Thursday, November 3 in Bowdle and at 7:00 pm on Monday, November 7 in Hoven.

Every year, a special plenary (full) indulgence applicable to the souls of the deceased is available on each of the days from November 1 to November 8 for praying for the faithful departed while making a visit to a cemetery, according to the usual conditions (free from attachment to sin, even venial sin; in the state of grace at the time of the indulgenced action; Confession within 20 days before or after, one Confession sufficing for multiple plenary indulgences; one reception of Holy Communion for each indulgence within the same time-frame; prayer for the intentions of the Pope, one Our Father and one Hail Mary being recommended for his intentions). In general, a maximum of one plenary indulgence can be gained each day.

A plenary indulgence has the effect of removing all punishment due to sin (all remaining time in purgatory for the souls of the deceased). Besides this special indulgence for souls of the deceased available November 1 to November 8, we can obtain a plenary indulgence applicable to oneself or to the deceased even every day of the year for certain actions. These include adoration of the Blessed Sacrament for at least half an hour (note that this

does not require Eucharistic exposition, but even a prayerful visit to any tabernacle where Jesus is present), devout reading of Sacred Scripture for at least half an hour, the pious exercise of the Way of the Cross, or the recitation of the Marian Rosary in a church or public oratory or in a family group, a religious Community or pious Association.

Throughout this month of November, prayer for the faithful departed receives a special emphasis, so be sure to visit the cemetery and pray for the poor souls.
