# Frequently Asked Questions: What is the name of the proposed amendment on abortion?

The Attorney General of South Dakota, who is required by law to summarize citizen-initiated ballot measures, has prepared the following title: "An Initiated Amendment Establishing a Right to Abortion in the State Constitution." The amendment would write into South Dakota's state constitution a sweeping right to obtain an abortion at any time up until the moment of birth. The Attorney General states the amendment "would override existing laws and regulations concerning abortion." Stay tuned for further information about the abortion amendment.

# Saint Alphonsus Rodriguez's Story

Tragedy and challenge beset today's saint early in life, but Alphonsus Rodriguez found happiness and contentment through simple service and prayer.

Born in Spain in 1533, Alphonsus inherited the family textile business at 23. Within the space of three years, his wife, daughter, and mother died. Alphonsus stepped back and reassessed his life, sold his business and moved into his sister's home with his son. There he learned the discipline of prayer & meditation.

At the death of his son years later, Alphonsus, almost 40 by then, sought to join the Jesuits. He applied twice before being admitted. For 45 years he served as doorkeeper at the Jesuits' college in Majorca. When not at his post, he was usually at prayer, though often encountering difficulties and temptations.

His holiness and prayerfulness attracted many to him, including Saint Peter Claver, then a Jesuit seminarian and poet and fellow Jesuit Gerard Manley Hopkins, who made him the subject of one of his poems.

Alphonsus died in 1617. He is the patron saint of Majorca.

Reflection: We like to think that God rewards the good, even in this life. But Alphonsus knew business losses, painful bereavement, and periods when God seemed very distant. None of his suffering made him withdraw into a shell of self-pity or bitterness. Rather, he reached out to others who lived with pain. Among the many notables at his funeral were the sick and poor people whose lives he had touched. May they find such a friend in us!
