Sacramental Preparation


Baptism: A pre-baptism meeting with Father must be completed before the baptism of a child. Contact Father to schedule.

The crib is set up and ready for you to Shower Christ's Little Ones. You may bring NEW gifts, including clothing (sizes newborn to 12 months),


diapers and other baby needs. These can all be placed in the crib.


