Father Michael's Musings



This coming Tuesday is the feast day of a young man named Joseph, who was one of the first believers in the Gospel message and an ardent supporter of the Apostles and their mission.

He is, however, not known generally by his birth name, but by the nickname given to him by the Apostles. They called him "Bar-Nabas," which is translated as "Son of Encouragement."

I often wonder what sort of man this Joseph must have been, what his day to day life was like, how he spoke and acted (above the brief glimpses given us in the Acts of the Apostles) that would cause the Apostles, those who had walked, talked and lived with Jesus in his earthly ministry, to give this man the exalted title of Son of Encouragement.

I also ask myself what I could be to have such a noble title added to my name as well. How about you? Life can be so crushing sometimes, we each have battles to fight and burdens to bear, doubts to confront and fear to overcome, what a gift to be encouraged by someone we love. What an extraordinary gift it is to be that person who encourages another in their struggles.

Inspired by Tuesday's Feast of St. Barnabas, may each of us strive anew to help one another, to care for one another, to support, comfort and encourage those who need our love the most. Whatever our name may be, we can all be Barnabas.

Joint Statement on the certification of the abortion petition

On May 16, 2024, the South Dakota Secretary of State certified for the November 5, 2024 election ballot a proposed constitutional amendment that would legalize abortion through all nine months of pregnancy. 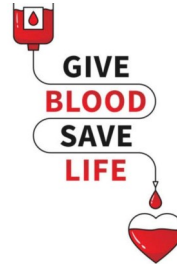
Mass Intentions Resume
