Father Michael's Musings



This Friday is the Feast of St. Cecilia, the patron saint of church music and musicians.

First of all, don't forget to thank your church musicians for their important ministry, and the incredible amount of time they spend planning, preparing, prac-

ticing and sharing the joyful songs of the Lord with us.

Second of all, spend a little time reflecting on the importance of our songs at Mass. Over and over the Scriptures invite us to sing, sing with joy, sing with sadness, sing with hope; how we respond to this invitation makes a difference in our lives.

Music expresses our emotions in ways that can elude the spoken word, with the exception of poetry.

Sometimes we can feel emotionally detached from the deep heart of the Eucharistic celebration, sometimes the words do not touch us in the depth of our being.

> We are invited then to sing, the songs of joy, the songs of lament.

Do not be afraid, it's not a concert and no one cares if you sing well or not: Sing out.

Do not be afraid, even if your grandpa and dad never sang a note: Sing out.

Do not be afraid, the Lord desires access to your heart: Sing out.

We are the children of God, we have no reason not to sing!


