Father Michael's Musings



It's a beautiful word, in Greek it is εὐχαριστία (eucharistia) which means "thanksgiving," but it also means more than that simple word implies. It means, in its own way, giving thanks to God that overflows with praise.

We praise God by giving Him thanks for his blessings, creation, life, joys and sorrows, love and family and friends, pets and laughter and song and everything, everything.

This Thursday our nation pauses for a day of giving thanks, and that is a gift. But as Roman Catholics, every time we celebrate the Eucharist, we are giving thanks to God with so much gratitude that it overflows with praise.

The gifts of bread and wine that are presented, blessed and placed upon the altar are the expressions of our thanks and our prayers.

During the offertory at Mass, take a moment and remember what you are thankful for, and offer that with the bread and wine. Remember those you have been asked to pray for, offer them as well.

This is how each celebration of the Eucharistia becomes a true time of Thanksgiving.


