Father Michael's Musings



We are in a time set aside each year to pray for Christian unity. It is a wonderful gift that we hear the beautiful passage of the wedding at Cana during this time.

We pause to remember that Jesus, at the beginning of His ministry in John's Gospel, performs His first sign at a wedding celebration, using this gift of unity as the foundation of His work.

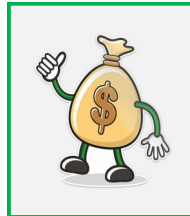
