Weather like we have been having reminds me of something Fr. Jim Moudry, the Liturgy professor in the seminary, once said: People in the south may celebrate Easter, but they don't understand Easter.

His meaning was, unless you have gone through real winter you don't understand the significance of spring, the warmth that begins to bring back to life everything that seemed dead. The earth itself lets go of its frost and there is a bounce to the soil again.

It's wonderful, and most meaningful after a time of deep below zero temperatures.

So, while it is difficult to endure, it helps to remember how even the time of cold can move us forward spiritually. Winter, like difficult days, can be a struggle but spring, like the renewal of life through grace, always returns and renews.

As an Easter people, even in the coldest days, we can bring forth springtime hope through our warmth, compassion, smiles and love. Winter, like the approaching Lenten Season, teaches us the meaning of Easter.




