Father Michael's Musings



This image, from the façade of the Basilica of St. John Lateran, the pope's cathedral church, is used as an expression of this time in the Church. The Pope's seal is usually made up of the Papal Tiara (crown) and the crossed keys of the Pope's authority.

At this time no one wears the tiara, it is replaced by the papal umbrella which overshadows the keys, as no one now bears that authority. The chair is empty.

It is the interregnum, the quiet time between popes. During this time, we pray for the Holy Father who has passed and pray for the conclave gathering to elect the next successor of St. Peter.

> That conclave begins this Wednesday, so we start praying now:

O God, eternal shepherd, who govern your flock with unfailing care, grant in your boundless fatherly love a pastor for your Church who will please you by his holiness and to us show watchful care. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God. for ever and ever. Amen.




