Father Michael's Musings



This coming Wednesday, July 11, is the Feast of Saint Benedict, and a special day of joy for Benedictine Brothers, Sisters and Oblates the world over.

Around the year 560, Benedict wrote his Rule for Life in a Monastery, a guide to lead communities to the middle way, between rigid conformity and the chaos of a life without direction or boundaries.

Lately I have been thinking about the directive Our Holy Father Benedict gives in Chapter 53 of his Holy Rule, "On the Reception of Guests;" he writes: "Let all guests be received as Christ."

I think of these summer months as people from all over the country come to our state to visit, recreate and vacation. They stop in our towns, they eat, buy snacks, ask questions, fill up with gas, stretch, look around.

How are they welcomed? How are they greeted? What if every person we saw, especially the stranger, was Christ coming to us?

Because, in a beautiful and mysterious way, He is.

We can make our towns beautiful, hang signs welcoming people and inviting them, but nothing speaks as beautifully as the welcome given, and the love shared, by the people who live there.

Be the welcome and beauty of your town, and, at the end, hear Jesus say, "I was a stranger, and you welcomed me."


