Memorial Day: The day set aside to solemnly remember and honor all who died in the service of our nation.

Veterans Day: A day to remember and honor all those who served in the United States Armed Forces, living or deceased.

Armed Forces Day: A day to honor those who are currently serving.

They walk among us.

Sometimes they wear a cap or some insignia mark of their service, but they may not. They may simply walk among us.

They may be suffering the lingering effects in their body or their mind of their time in service. They may carry within themselves the many memories and lessons of their time in uniform as they simply walk among us.
